

Family Online Safety Contract

- I will not give out personal information like my name, address, telephone number, parents' work address or phone number, or the name and location of my school without my parents' permission.
- I will tell my parents right away if I come across any information that makes me feel uncomfortable, angry, embarrassed or sad.
- I will not call anyone I meet online without asking my parents first.
- I will not answer any e-mails or messages from someone I don't know.
- If someone online asks me to do something I am not supposed to do, I will tell my parents right away.
- I will never agree to get together with someone I "meet" online without first checking with my parents. If my parents agree to the meeting, I will be sure that it is in a public place, during the day, and I'll bring my mom or dad along.
- I will never send anyone my picture or anything else without first checking with my parents.
- I will not respond to any messages that are mean or in any way make me feel uncomfortable. It is not my fault if I get a message like that. If I do, I will tell my parents right away so that they can contact the Internet service provider.
- I will talk with my parents so that we can set up rules for going online. We will decide upon the time of day I can be online, the length of time I can be online, and appropriate areas for me to visit. I will not visit other areas or break these rules without their permission.
- I will not give out my internet password to anyone (even my best friends) except my parents.
- I will be a good online citizen and not do anything that hurts other people, or is against the law.
